

Deutsch Langhaar (DLH)

Body

The Deutsch Langhaar is a large, well muscled cat, with a long, rectangular body.

The chest is round and well developed, the neck is strong.

The muscular legs are of medium length; the large paws are round and firm and tufts between toes.

Tail

The tail is of medium length, broad at the base and becoming more slender ending in a slightly rounded tip.

Head

The trapezoidal head with high set rounded cheeks and blunt muzzle is longer than wide.

The wide chin is moderately developed.

The slightly curved profile ends in a medium long, broad nose, which curves slightly roman.

Ears

The ears are medium sized, slightly diagonal and placed far apart. They are broad at the base and have a rounded tip.

Eyes

The eyes are oval, large and open. They stand slightly diagonal and in far distance to each other.

The eyes are uniformly coloured. All eye colours are permitted.

Blue and odd eyes are allowed only in pure white, 01 (van) 02 (harlequin) and 03 (bicolour) providing there is a white mask.

Coat

The cat has a long coat, a collar and "Knickerbockers" (fluffy coated trousers on the backlegs).

The coat is of shining, silky structure and has undercoat. Preference is to be given to a long coat that divides down the spine.

Colour varieties

All coat colours are permitted.

Faults

- Too short coat
- Missing undercoat

Faults that exclude the certificate

- Too straight profile
- Stop

Disqualification

- Resembles any other breed
- Eye colour not corresponding with coat colour
