



Part D - Rights and duties of the WCF judge

1. A WCF judge cannot be obliged to give a certificate (title), neither by the organising club nor by other persons.
2. A WCF judge is not obliged to accept a student judge at an exhibition, but he should give sound reasons for the rejection. The assignment of more than one student judge is not possible, this includes student judges who take an exam.
3. A WCF judge is only allowed to vote in the Best in Show for the cats of the categories for which he is licensed.
4. A WCF judge is not allowed to award CACM and CAPM at other exhibitions than those of WCF members.
5. At WCF exhibitions at which he judges, the judge may only exhibit his cats out of competition, also cats that live in his household.
6. In the case of changing the club-membership WCF-Judges are obliged to inform the chairperson of the Judge's Commission within 4 weeks.

The Judges Commission is responsible for informing all WCF judges within 60 days of any changes to breed standards once they are released for publication.
